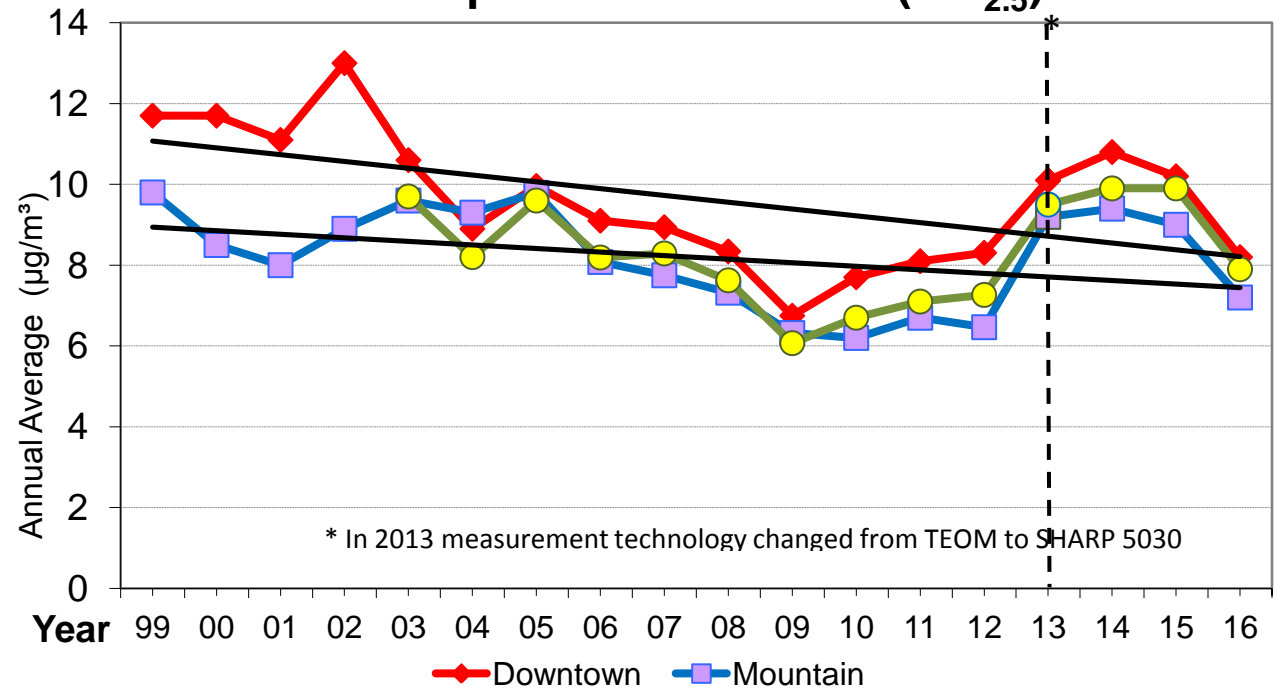
Formed in 1998, Clean Air Hamilton works to improve air quality in Hamilton by:

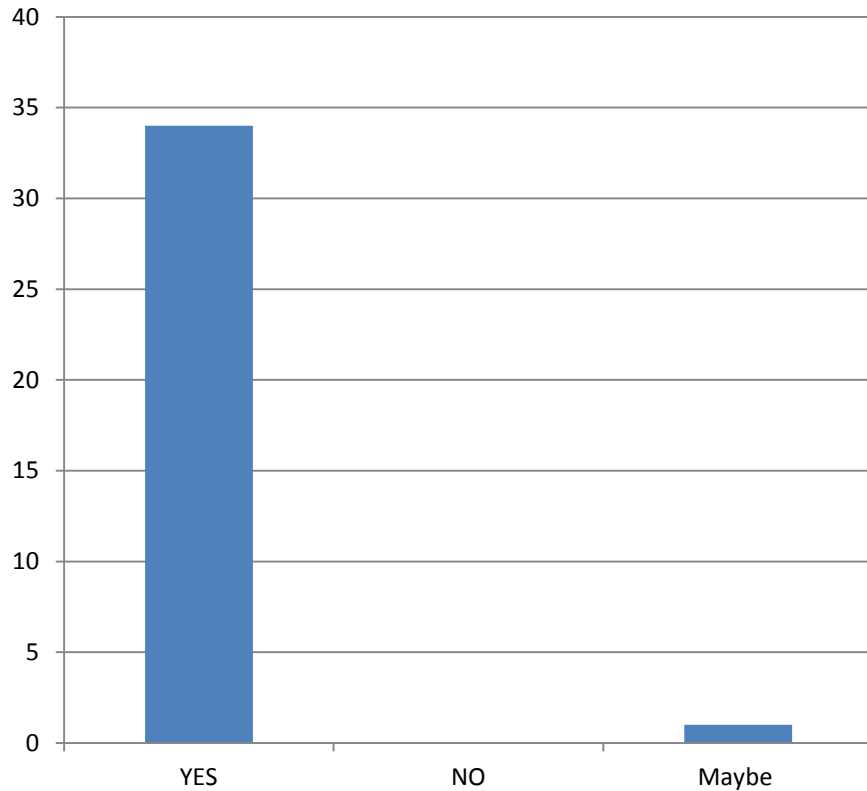

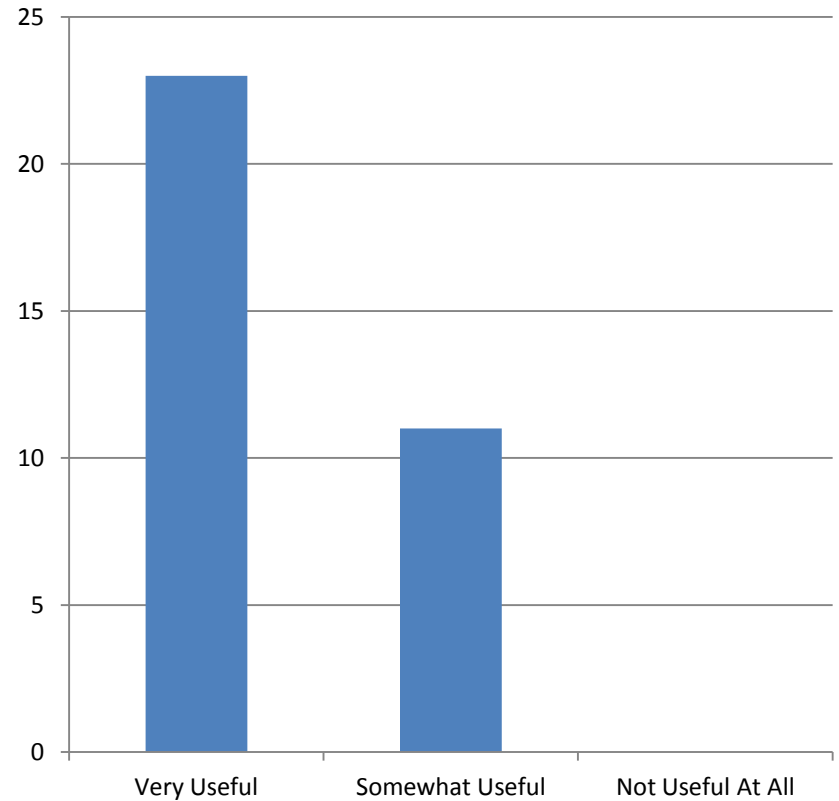

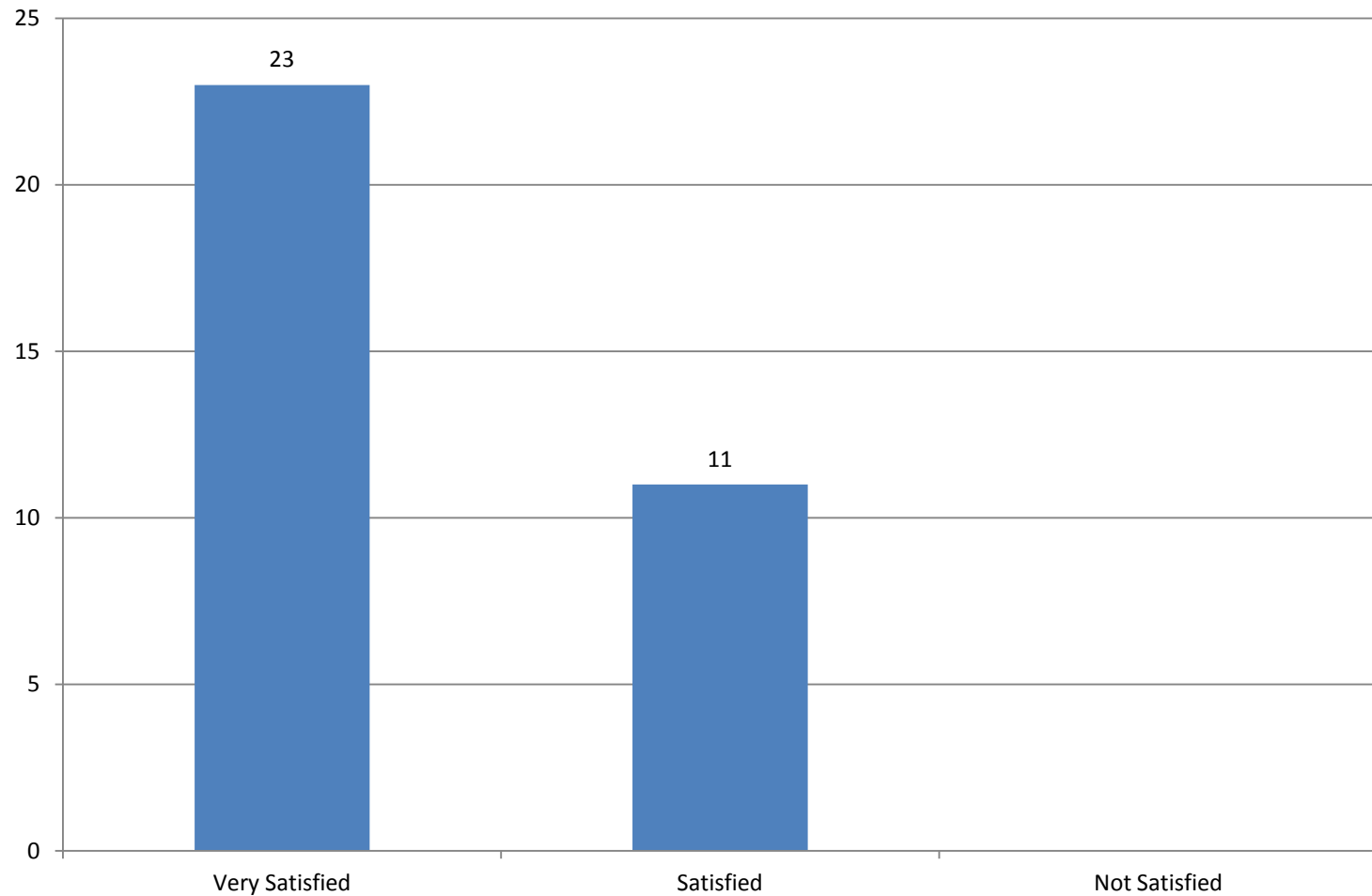
