

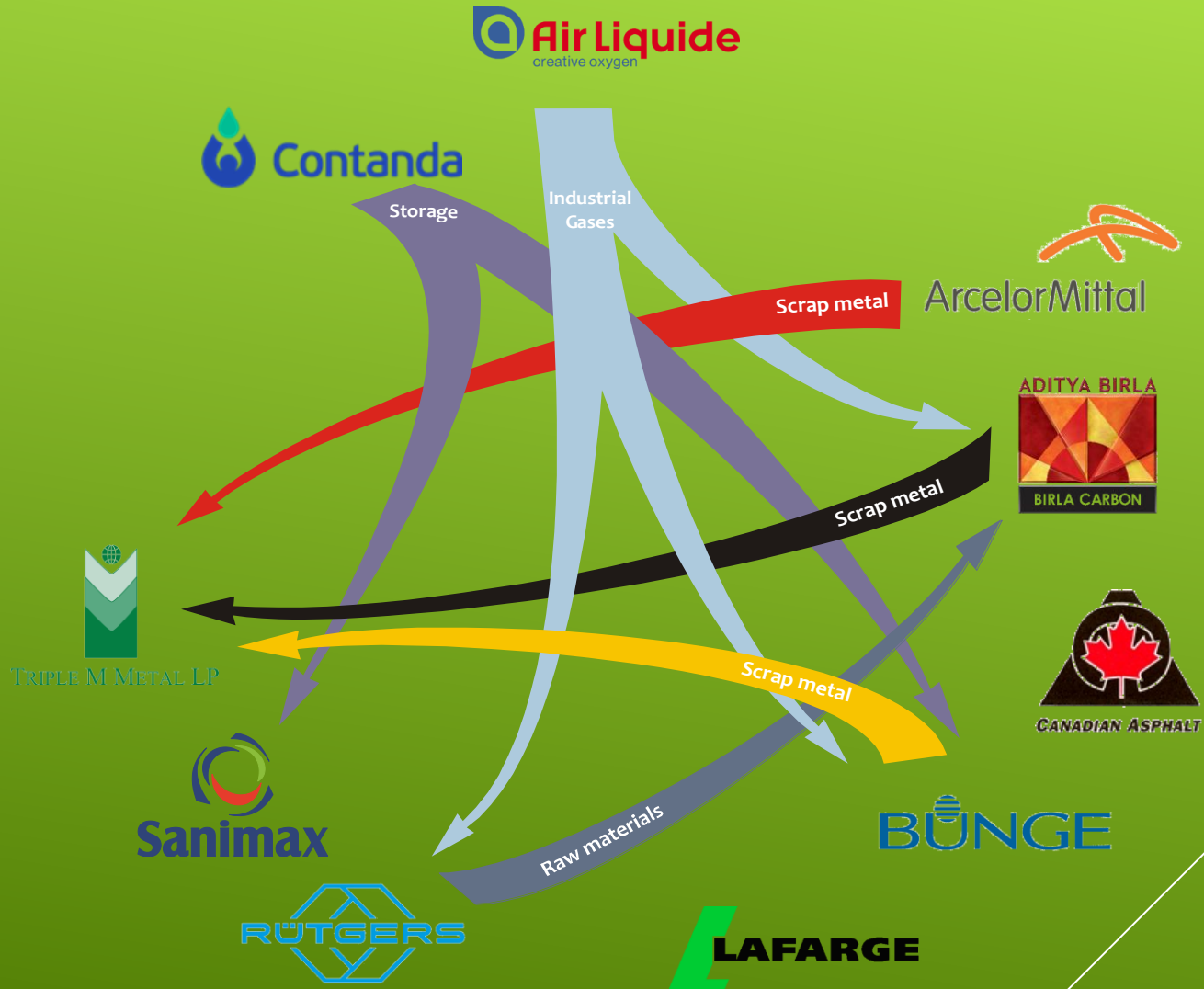

The diagram below shows HIEA's current function with all members.



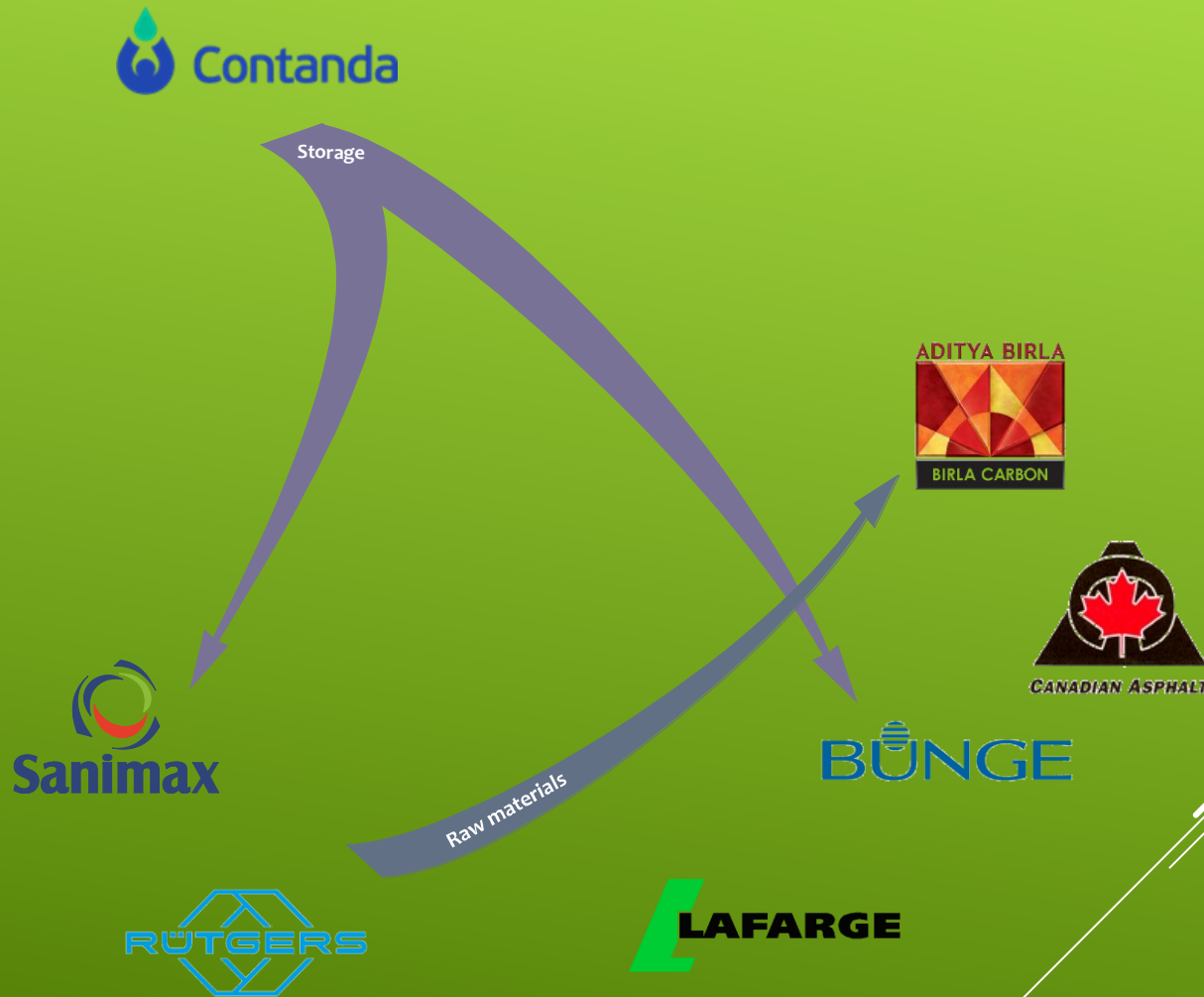
This diagram shows how HIEA would look without Stelco and ArcelorMittal Dofasco




The diagram below shows the absence of HIEA's most active companies (Air Liquide and Triple M Metal).

- ▶ Without Stelco and ArcelorMittal Dofasco, companies like Air Liquide and Triple M Metals would no longer have a strong customer base in Hamilton.
 - ▶ Air Liquide's biggest customers are the steel companies; for example Air Liquide has teamed up with ArcelorMittal Dofasco to install a 12 million dollar pipeline that carries oxygen to the plant.
 - ▶ Triple M Metals, as a supplier of recycled metals to the steel industry, would lose a major customer.
