**2. "Taking Stock – Green House Gas Emissions in Hamilton" presentation – Brian Montgomery**

Climate Change issues are impacting municipalities and Brian indicated that insurance companies are even refusing to provide policies to municipalities who do not have a climate change program. Hamilton has developed the 350 climate change committee to develop plans that will reduce green house gases and a climate change strategic plan for Hamilton. One of the first steps will include developing an inventory of sources in the community but the initial plan will not include traffic moving through the city. They will use 2006 as the base year to tie in with information included in the last census. Using information from other communities they will look at less polluting alternative energy sources. Brian is looking for feedback over the next 6 – 8 months. Town halls will be held to provide input and enable the committee to develop a community plan which can be taken to city council for approval.
